 - All applicants must complete the online <u>pre-application</u> by 5:00 p.m. PST on June 29, 2020. WCB will then invite select applicants to submit full proposals.
- The Alliance for Water Efficiency (AWE) is still accepting applications for its Learning Landscapes Grant Program. Application deadline is June 30.
