Items of Interest

- There are a couple funding opportunities:
 - A. More money is now available to farmers impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic through the USDA's Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP-2). This is its second round of funding and will provide \$13.21 billion in aid to farmers over the next few months. The application window for this program is from September 21 December 11, 2020, and checks are expected to be mailed to farmers within a week or two of approved applications.  - a. USDA is also providing free assistance with applying to this program, including preparing and submitting the required paperwork.

 - A call center is also available for producers who would like additional support with the CFAP 2 application process. Please call 877-508-8364 to speak directly with a USDA employee ready to offer assistance.
 - B. The Department of Water Resources (DWR) is offering \$26 Million in Competitive Grants for Critically Overdrafted (COD) Basins. They have released the final <u>Proposition 68 Implementation Proposal Solicitation Package</u> for the Sustainable Groundwater Management Grant Program. The program will award \$26 million to critically overdrafted groundwater basins for Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) implementation projects that address drought and groundwater challenges, groundwater recharge projects, or projects that prevent or clean up contaminated groundwater used for drinking water.
 - a. An assistance workshop webinar will be held December 3, 2020, at 2 p.m., to review the application process and answer questions. <u>Registration</u> is now open.
 - b. Round 1 grant applications must be submitted using DWR's <u>online</u> <u>submittal tool</u> and will be accepted from November 9, 2020, through January 8, 2021.
 - c. A Round 2 solicitation is expected to open in Spring 2022 and will offer at least \$77 million in additional grants for medium priority, high priority, and critically overdrafted basins.
