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Update on Madera County Groundwater Sustainability Agencies Implementation

- Under SGMA, the GSAs have the ability to assess penalties for using more water than allocated.
- Penalties would need to be established under an ordinance.
- Options include (either or both):
 - A civil penalty up to \$500/AF extracted in excess of any amount the person is authorized to extract.
 - A civil penalty not to exceed \$1,000 plus \$100 for each additional day after 30-days of notice.



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Update on Madera County Groundwater Sustainability Agencies Implementation

- GSA assumes all current/recent irrigating parcels are “in” and will have access to allocations
- To “opt out” requires a contract with the GSA for each parcel stating you will not:
 - access sustainable yield over the next five years
 - access sustainable yield this year
 - access transitional water this year
- GSA will monitor use and non-use.
- Staff recommends penalties as:
 - up to \$500/AF penalty for pumping beyond the allocation
 - \$1,000 civil penalty and \$100 for each additional day after notification
 - The penalty amount would be determined at the end of the water year or calendar year.



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
