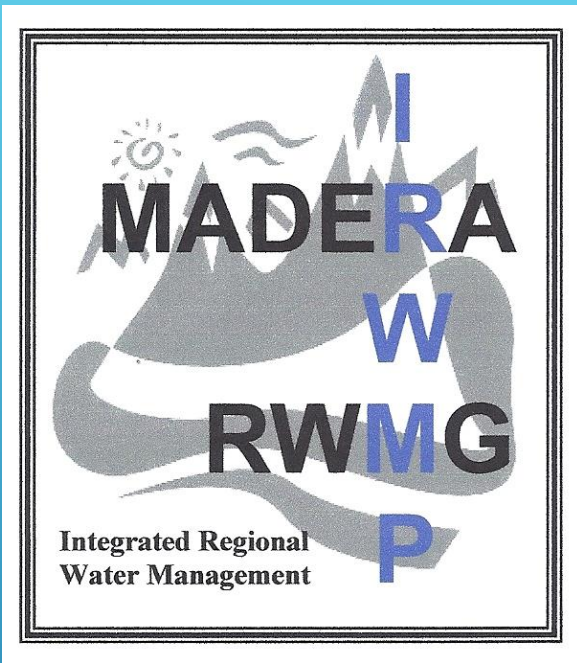
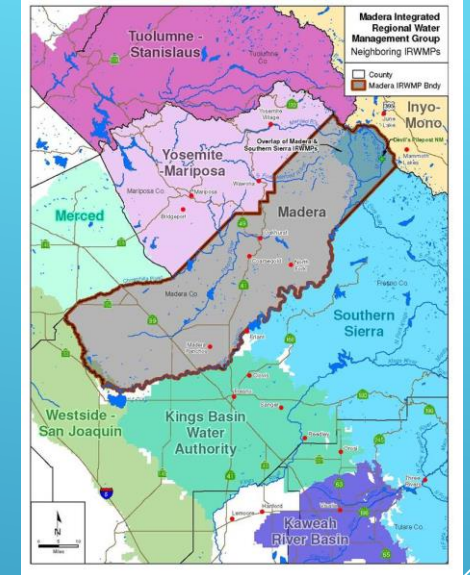

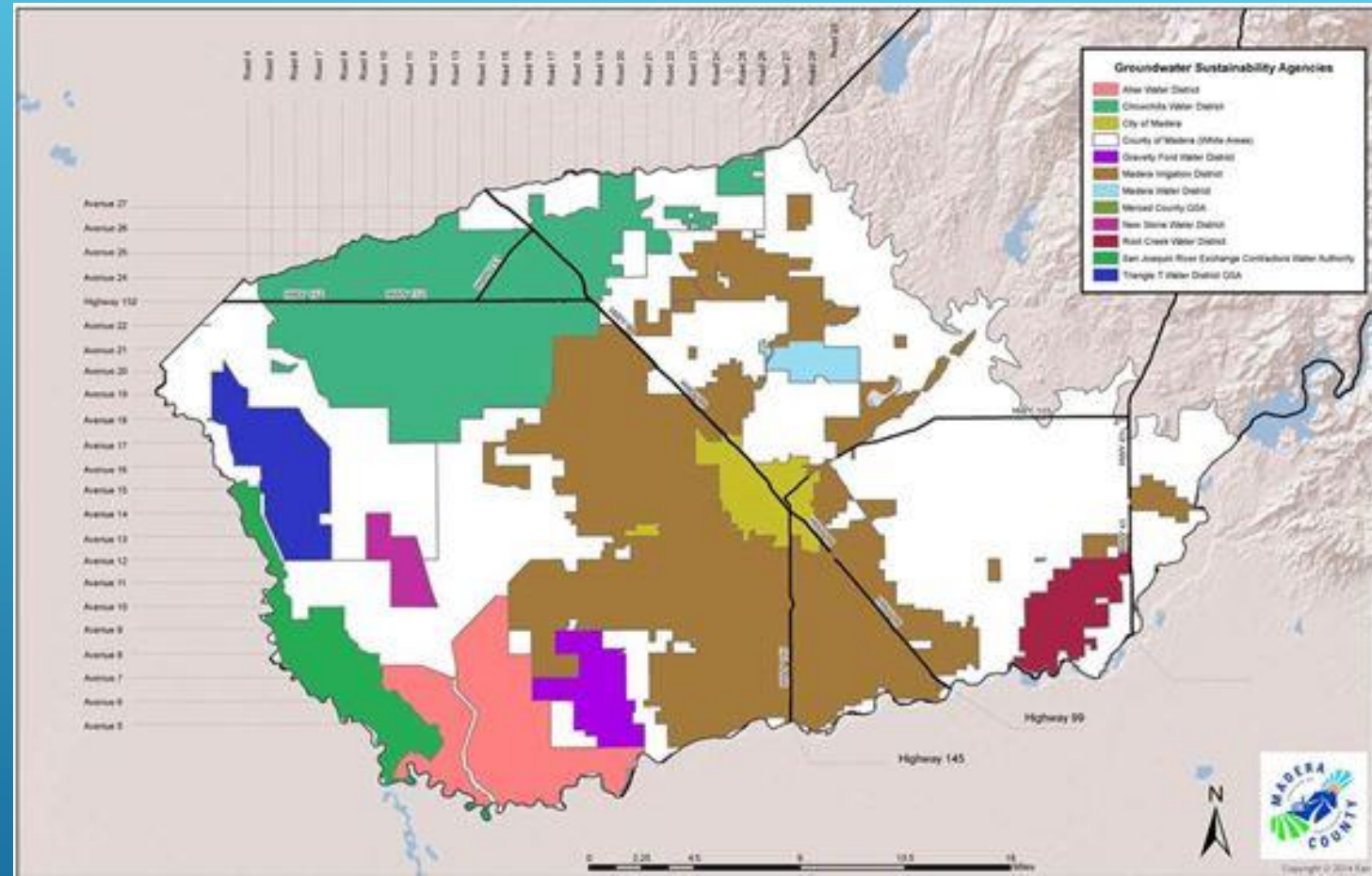
- The Madera RWMG covers all areas within the Madera County boundary
- Eligible for funding in the San Joaquin River Funding Area and the Mountain Counties Funding Area
- The group works to address water issues, including groundwater and surface water quality and quantity
- The group consists of local water districts, irrigation districts, GSAs, DACs, local government departments, tribal organizations, nonprofit organizations, and
- public members

PROP. 1 FUNDING

A total of \$3.1 billion was awarded to the IRWM Regions in the SJRFA

Out of the total amount awarded, the Madera Region received \$148,000 initially, and then an additional \$152,400 in funding

With the additional funding received by the Madera RWMG, up to 150 households can receive free well testing through organizations that the group has partnered with on this project with a deadline date of July 31, 2022
