CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE

The Political Reform Act, Government Code Sections 81000, et seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate Conflict of Interest Codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard Conflict of Interest Code, which can be incorporated by reference, and which may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act after public notice and hearing. Therefore, the terms of 2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, along with the attached Appendix A in which officials and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, are hereby incorporated by reference and constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the Gravelly Ford Water District.

The Board of Directors shall file their Conflict of Interest statements with the Madera County Clerk-Recorder who is designated as the filing officer for the District Directors by the Cal. Code of Regs. as amended.

The General Manager/Manager and Controller shall file their Conflict of Interest statements with the District.

Statements on file with the District will be available for public inspection and reproduction. (Gov. Code Section 81008). Required statements for employees will be retained by the District.

**CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE

APPENDIX A**

General Provisions

1. Investments and business positions in any business entity or sources of income listed under "Reportable Items" of this Appendix A are disclosable if:
 - a. The business entity in which the investment or business position is held is of the type which has contracted with Gravelly Ford Water District within the previous two years; or
 - b. The business entity in which the investment or business position is held is of the type which has contracted within the previous two years to furnish supplies or services as subcontractors in any contract with Gravelly Ford Water District; or
 - c. The sources of income are of the type which have contracted with the Authority within the previous calendar year; or
 - d. The sources of income are of the type which have contracted within the previous calendar year to furnish supplies or services as subcontractors in any contract with Gravelly Ford Water District.

 2. Investments and business positions in any business entity or sources of income which are (1) private water companies, or (2) entities or persons engaged in farming, real estate development, or owners of real estate; and interests in real property are disclosable if held, regardless of any contractual relationship with Gravelly Ford Water District at any time.

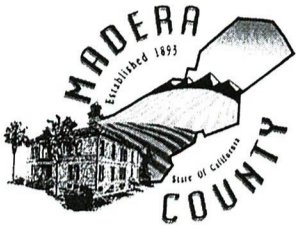
