Any person addressing the Group under public comment will be limited to a 3-minute presentation to ensure that all interested parties have an opportunity to speak. Also, all persons addressing the Group must state their name and county of residence for the record.

Items of Interest

- The <u>California Financing Coordinating Committee (CFCC)</u> is holding free virtual funding fairs on October 19th and November 3rd to educate the public and potential customers about available funding. The funding fairs also include an opportunity to discuss your projects with financial representatives from each agency. CFCC members facilitate and expedite the completion of various types of infrastructure projects by helping customers combine the resources of different agencies. Presentations will be held from 9 am to about 12:30 pm, and participants can visit virtual booths from 12:30 pm to 2 pm to meet with representatives. See the attached flyer for more information.
- The <u>California Fire Safe Council County Coordinator Grant</u> is accepting applications through November 15th. This program will provide one-time funding of \$175,000 for county-wide Fire Safe coordination efforts, including costs for a designated County Coordinator, for counties that did not receive funding through the 2021-22 County Coordinator Grant Program.
- The 2023 Nonpoint Source (NPS) grant program is now open and accepting applications through 5 pm on December 19th. The program seeks proposals for projects that reduce runoff of pollution to waters of the state, such as agricultural projects that reduce pesticide and nutrient runoff, improvement or decommission of dirt roads to reduce erosion and sediment runoff, streambank stabilization to reduce erosion, marina programs to reduce toxic discharges from anti-fouling paints on boats, and infrastructure improvements for ranching and livestock operations to reduce erosion and runoff of nutrients and pathogens.

The 2023 NPS grant program guidelines describe program preferences, eligibility requirements, application process and instructions, project selection criteria, and the grant award process. Please note that one of the minimum eligibility requirements is to consult with the NPS Grant Coordinator in the corresponding Regional Water Board listed in Appendix 7 of the guidelines.

DWR has released the final <u>2022 Guidelines/Proposal Solicitation Package</u> for the <u>Urban Community Drought Relief Grant Program</u>. There is approximately \$284 million available through this solicitation for interim or immediate relief in response to conditions arising from drought across California. The drought relief goal is to address immediate impacts on human health and safety and on fish and wildlife resources, and to provide water to persons or communities that lose or are threatened with the loss or contamination of water supplies.
