### Secured Area Ingress Controls

Movement may be necessary into areas secured due to evacuation. Ingress of public safety vehicles (law, fire, EMS) will be controlled by Incident Commander. Ingress of the following two types that will be controlled with a pass system operated by Security Group/Division:

Type I: Levee maintaining staff/equipment performing flood fight operations.  
Type II: Citizens/Residents participating in evacuation activities.  
Pass issuance policy will be set by City Incident Commander.

Level	Condition	Action
I	More than 2" of rain are expected over a 24-hour period	Prepare to implement traffic control at known problem areas
II	Overtopping OR localized drainage is expected within 48 in Populated Area	Implement traffic control, consider evacuation, consider sandbag protection of impacted buildings
