MEASUREMENT

Meters

If you are using private meters as your measurement method and have preapproval to use meters, you must submit your meter readings using the <u>flowmeter portal</u> for each meter by the 10th of each month. If you do not, you will be shifted to Land IQ, but you will still be able to use your meters as a back-up measurement.

IrriWatch

If IrriWatch is your measurement method, your reports for the previous month will be live around the 10th of the month.

Land IQ

If you chose Land IQ as your measurement method, you will receive hard copies of your reports as soon as humanly possible.
