If you would like to change your measurement method to Land IQ or to Irriwatch, now is the time! Forms will be mailed out within the next week to allow you to change your measurement method for 2024. You can also contact your Water Resources Specialist to make changes.

The deadline to submit these requests is January 19, 2024.

If no request is received by the deadline, your measurement method will remain the same. If you wish to keep your measurement method, no further action will be needed. Please keep an
