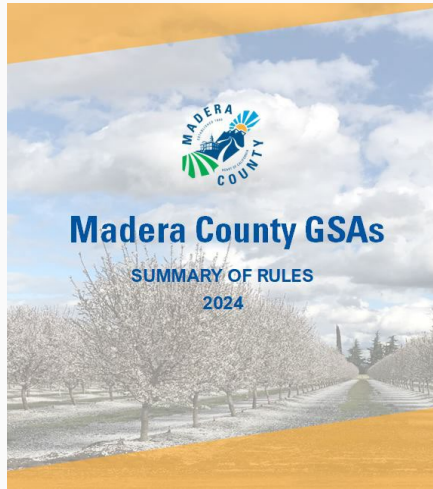
Your input matters!
