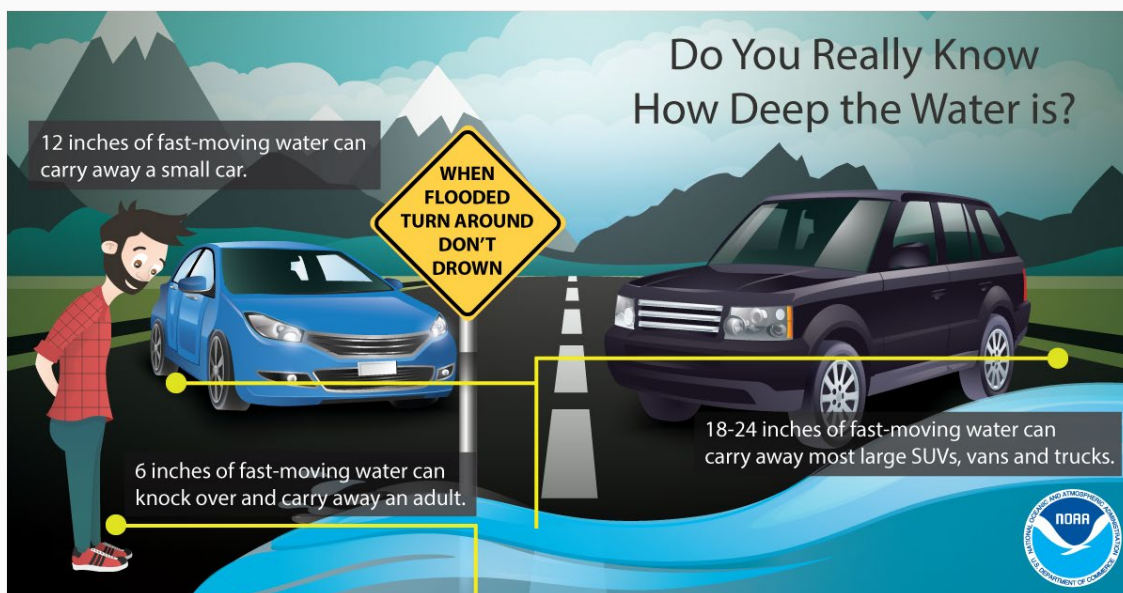
FLOOD WARNING
