The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is accepting written comments regarding the 2024 Triennial Review Draft Workplan (Draft Workplan) through July 29th for both the Sacramento River and San Joaquin River Basins, and the Tulare Lake Basin. On Monday next week, July 8th, Central Valley Water Board staff with hold a workshop to provide participants with an opportunity to discuss the Central Valley Water Board's 2024 Triennial Review Draft Workplan.

The Draft Workplan includes a review of Basin Plan amendments since the 2021 Triennial Review, an overview of proposed projects, available Board resources, and project prioritization and ranking.

Written comments on the Draft Workplan will be accepted at the Rancho Cordova office and through email. Staff will compile comments and use them to inform the development of the Draft Workplan that will be presented to the Central Valley Water Board for adoption in a future meeting.
