MEASUREMENT METHOD

The Hydrosat (formerly Irriwatch) and Land IQ contracts are set to expire at the end of 2025. Based on feedback received through a grower questionnaire and following a comprehensive public request for proposals (RFP) process, the Board of Directors approved a resolution to enter into an agreement with Hydrosat to provide remote sensing services for the Madera County GSAs on December 09, 2025.

2026-2040 Allocation Information

Madera County GSAs Allocation FAQ

What is an allocation?

An allocation is a water budget made available to agricultural water users within the Madera County Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs). Over time, the allocated water budget will decrease to sustainable levels.

Who has an allocation?

There are allocations for irrigated acres within the Madera County GSAs in the Madera, Chowchilla, and Delta-Mendota Subbasins.

What makes up an allocation?

Allocations are made up of two types of water. Sustainable Yield (SY) and Transitional Water (TW).

- SY is the amount of natural groundwater present in the subbasins through seepage and percolation.
- TW is excess groundwater being pumped from the subbasins; this decreases over time until it reaches zero.

How is my allocation calculated?

If your land has been irrigated prior to June 08, 2021 (Resolution 2021-069) then you will receive both SY and TW. If you decide to opt-in "Never Irrigated" lands you are only eligible to receive SY for the irrigated acreage portion. Please see tables below.

What happens if I am under my allocation?

You will be able to carryover unused allocation to the following calendar year. Currently, carryover does not have any decay factor and/or expiration date.

What happens if I go over my allocation?

Currently, there are penalties in place for using water over the farm unit allocation. See the table for amounts per year.

2026 OPT-IN ENROLLMENT

Letters have been sent out to landowners who have parcels classified as Never Irrigated in the Madera County GSA. Landowners who have parcels classified as Never Irrigated and intend to use groundwater for irrigated agriculture in 2026 will need to notify the County GSAs by **December 30, 2025**. Please keep an eye out for the letter as it contains more information on this process. Approved parcels will be allocated a sustainable yield and come with associated fees and reporting requirements.

SURFACE WATER CREDITS

We are accepting surface water usage documentation for 2025. In order to obtain surface water credits please reach out to your Water Resources Specialist for more information on the documents required to be submitted to the Madera County GSAs for review.

FALLOW FIELD VISITS

Did you know if your field is fallow (for the full calendar year), we can zero it out to make sure ETAW is not picked up?
