Subject: Request for Review of Madera County GSA Domestic Well Mitigation Program Financials

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Directors, Madera County GSA:

Last August in 2025, the Board of Directors of the MCGSA took action to levy a \$59 GSP Project Fee for domestic well mitigation on the MCGSA enrolled irrigated acres. At the time of this action, there was much discussion regarding the program governance, the program requirements, and the level of the fee for the program. The MCGSA committed to a review of the financials of the domestic well mitigation program in April of 2026 to provide a sufficient review period prior to the 2026-2027 property tax roll statements being issued in June of 2026. This commitment was made in order to determine at what level the GSP Project Fee should be assessed for the 2026-2027 property tax cycle.

I am requesting the review of the MCGSA domestic well mitigation program be conducted at the MCGSA Committee meetings in March and April of 2026 in order to provide enough

preparation and discussion time for review for action by the MCGSA Board on Tuesday, April 14, 2026. This review should include but not be limited to:

- the current program requirements for acceptance for a domestic well to be funded for mitigation.
- application example for the domestic well mitigation program.
- number of vetted applicants with submitted applications.
- funds collected to date.
- funds expected to be collected with the April 10, 2026 property tax collection date.
- funds expected to be collected from the fines associated with water usage in excess of water allocation.
- funds disbursed to date within categories of expense.
- expected amount of funds in the program as of May 1, 2026.
